

Portrait Merge

Objective: Students begin learning how to use Photoshop by combining images.

Instructions: Working with an assigned partner, students take a portrait shot, making sure both lighting and exposure are appropriate. Students then switch images with one another so they are working with the picture of themselves.

Students select a pair of supplied glasses and shoot a photo of their chosen glasses to match the position of their portrait. In Photoshop, students must edit their portrait to put the glasses on their face to make it look as natural as possible.

Students submit three total photos: original portrait, glasses photo, and merged photo.
